

You were at the Emergency Room (ER) of Beatrix Hospital in Gorinchem today. This flyer contains additional information for your treatment.

## Pain relief

You can and may use the following painkillers:

- Paracetamol 2 tablets/suppositories 4 times a day 500 mg
- Diclofenac 3 times a day 50 mg or ibuprofen 3 times a day 400 mg
- Pantozol (stomach protector) when using diclofenac or ibuprofen.
- Tramadol 3 times a day 50 mg
- Movicolon for a soft stool
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# Reducing the pain killers

For two to three days after your visit to the Emergency Room, take the specified amount of painkillers. If you continue to have pain after that, you can continue to take the medication indicated. When the pain subsides, you can reduce the painkillers. First reduce the ibuprofen, diclofenac or tramadol. Continue to take 2 tablets of paracetamol 4 times a day, so also while reducing the other painkillers. If you no longer take any diclofenac, ibuprofen or tramadol, you can reduce the paracetamol.



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#### When should I seek medical attention?

If you develop the following symptoms, you can contact the Emergency Room at tel. (0183) 64 44 11:

- Severe nausea and/or vomiting
- Unable to eat and/or drink
- Severe abdominal pain
- Severe tightness of the chest
- Chest pain
- Drowsiness or not easily responsive
- High fever (or fever that does not diminish with antibiotics after 24-48 hours)
- Signs of inflammation in wounds (fever, redness, swelling, pain)
- Increased pain in the cast for which your painkiller is ineffective or insufficient
- Other complaints you do not trust
